A. For access to sites designated as “A” in the above Figure H, the following shall apply:

1. The sites **shall** offer unescorted 24x7 access to named technicians (no shared group access allowed; access **shall** be granted to individuals only). Access is described in the ARE-ON “Colocation Policies and Procedures” document, which will be provided to awardees within 30 after award. Physical installation work at the sites **must** be completed during normal State business hours.
2. For escorted service, the ARE-ON rates billed to DIS **shall** be \$150/hr with a 2-hour minimum for on-site access if needed. Travel to site **shall** be billed by ARE-ON to DIS at \$75/hr one-way. Emergency requests **shall** be billed by ARE-ON to DIS at \$250/hr with a 2-hour minimum. Escort requests **must** be made 72 hours in advance. ARE-ON’s support for emergency escorted access **shall** be on a best effort basis. Engineer’s travel time may be significant to some sites. Vendor **must** obtain written pre-approval from DIS prior to using escorted service.
3. Escorted and non-escorted access requests **shall** be made through email communications (noc@areon.net) or by calling the answering service/NOC center. The phone number for access will be provided within 30 days after award.
4. The vendor equipment **shall** be in a shared rack provided by the State. The huts **shall** be all open shared spaces with no provision for cages or suites. Space may be limited at some sites and **shall** be granted on an “as available” basis as determined by DIS. It is possible that in limited space situations like NWPT, a wall mounting may be needed. If so, the vendor **must** provide the wall mounted rack.

5. -48 volt fuse panels will be provided at the top of the rack and **shall** be shared among all of the occupants of the rack. Power feeds to a device on the shared fuse panel **shall** be limited to 20 amps. "A" and "B" power feeds generally can be accommodated as determined by DIS. A dedicated fuse panel may be an option and **shall** be available on an Individual Case Basis as determined by DIS.
6. The sites are each protected by an 8' chain link fence with a combination padlock on the gate. The buildings are protected by electronic access systems. Unescorted access through proximity cards **shall** be granted to named individuals who have been through an appropriate training session as specified by DIS. Equipment racks within the sites **shall** be open; there are no cages or suites. There **shall** not be any locked cabinets at the sites.
7. Any existing agreements/contracts or future agreements/contracts that a vendor (co-locator) may have with ARE-ON **shall** not be replaced, changed, or modified by any resulting contract issued for this IFB.

B. For access to the site designated as "B" in the above Figure H, the following shall apply:

1. 24/7 escorted access **shall** be granted for maintenance and installation work. Physical installation work at the sites **must** be completed during normal State business hours.
2. During normal FYVLAREE business hours, there **shall** be no fee for escorted access. Outside of normal business hours, the University is contractually authorized to charge a reasonable fee for any personnel cost incurred. DIS will pay this fee, but the vendor **must** obtain written pre-approval from DIS prior to using after hours escorted service.
3. Vendor requiring access **must** contact DIS Network Support on 501-682-4357 who will make all the needed arrangements. Access to FYVLAREE may take additional time as UAF personnel **must** provide the escort.
4. The vendor equipment **shall** be in a shared cabinet.
5. Outlets for 120v or 240v can be provided for the vendor. The cost to provide the outlets will be borne by the State. Vendor **must** provide to DIS the outlet quantity and type 30 days prior to installation.
6. At a minimum, the University facilities **shall** require appropriate badge access, or be escorted, to enter.

C. For access to the DIS sites designated as "C" in the above Figure H, the following shall apply:

1. 24/7 escorted access **shall** be granted for maintenance and installation work. Physical installation work at the sites **must** be completed during normal State business hours.
2. There will not be a charge for escorted access.
3. Vendor requiring access **must** contact DIS Network Support on 501-682-4357 who will make all the needed arrangements. In most cases escorted access to LTRKAR42 AND LTRKARXZ can be provided very soon after requested.
4. The vendor equipment **shall** be in a shared cabinet provided by DIS.
5. Outlets for 120v or 240v can be provided. The cost to provide the outlets will be borne by the State. Vendor **must** provide to DIS the outlet quantity and type 30 days prior to installation.
6. At a minimum, the facility **shall** require badge access, or sign-in and escorted, to enter.

The specifications by virtue of this addendum become a permanent addition to the above referenced IFB. FAILURE TO RETURN THIS SIGNED ADDENDUM MAY RESULT IN REJECTION OF YOUR BID.

BIDS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNTIL THE TIME AND DATE SPECIFIED. THE BID ENVELOPE **MUST** BE SEALED AND SHOULD BE PROPERLY MARKED WITH THE IFB NUMBER, DATE AND HOUR OF BID OPENING AND BIDDER'S RETURN ADDRESS. IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO RETURN "NO BIDS" TO THE OFFICE OF STATE PROCUREMENT.
