5.	<p>Approximately how many financial examinations do you expect to be performed in a year?</p> <p>See Addendum 1.</p>
6.	<p>What was the annual cost to the AID for these same actuarial services? If you are unable to share the specific cost, is it possible to get a price range?</p> <p>This information can be obtained through the Freedom Of Information Act.
