EBD Case Management Proposed Trigger List for Telephonic Case Management/Care Coordination for Small Case Management	
High Risk Pregnancy	Any complication as referred.
Infectious Diseases	Any inpatient with Cellulitis, any kind of wound requiring dressing changes daily or more often, patient requiring IV antibiotics, admission for gastroenteritis, dehydration, osteomyelitis, etc.
Respiratory Diseases	Asthma-frequent admissions, Ventilator Dependent-any hospital admission, Pneumonia-any hospital admission, Cystic Fibrosis-frequent hospital admissions, COPD-frequent hospital admissions, primary pulmonary hypertension.
Pediatric Admissions	Accident/injuries, AIDS, cancer, diabetes, cardiac disorders, pulmonary diseases, birth defects, burns, new born complications.
Cancer	Malignant tumors and diseases, especially with known metastasis, when treatment is intense, complicated, or expected to utilize significant resources. Inpatient chemotherapy, hospice pain management admissions.
Wounds	Any wound requiring skilled dressing changes of such frequency, intensity, severity and complexity, that is precludes the patient or caregiver from reasonably performing the task, any wound requiring a wound vac.
Transplant Admissions to Non-Transplant Facilities, Transplant CM	High dose chemotherapy, complications pre/post transplant, provide transplant coordination of benefits and Case Management.
Length of stay	Any length of stay greater than 5 days.
Bariatric Surgery	Using program defined criteria.
