ANSWERS ARE IN BLUE

1. I have read all the documents from the web site and am totally confused as to how to start. Is this just to get us started with the State of Arkansas or to get put up for the award of contract?

Answer: See RFQ Sections 2.1 and 2.2.

2. We are inquiring about Solicitation Number SP-19-0048 to see if the following are items that can be proposed for this contract:
 - a. In-Car Video Camera Systems
 - b. Interview Room Camera Systems
 - c. Body-Worn Camera Systems
 - d. Corresponding Evidence Management Platforms and On-Premise, Hybrid, and Cloud Storage Solutions.

Answer: See RFQ Section 2.4

3. The RFQ does not work in the same way that Cooperative Contracts have worked in the past, meaning there will not be a set dollar amount maximum that a Purchasing Entity can contract a Prospective Contractor on the QVL for that is outside of the "standard" contracting process. For example, we've seen verbiage on some cooperative contracts that says up to \$250,000. I know we specifically discussed TIPS, but just to confirm, once the QVL is finalized, Cooperative Contract purchasing for any Audio Visual Equipment and Supplies projects will cease to exist. In the interim (between now and the QVL being finalized), Purchasing Entities can continue to use Cooperative Contracts for purchasing, including TIPS.
